Safety Response Reminders

- 1. MEDICAL EMERGENCY: Whenever possible call 911 from your location. You will be able to provide details about your situation which could help with the emergency response. A follow-up call, when appropriate, to notify Lathrop is helpful. If you cannot call 911 the pendant or pull cord system is designed to get you the help you need.
- 2. **EMERGENCY PENDANTS**: When the button is pushed, the red light will flash. The response system is notified, and you will be called to determine the nature of your emergency. *If you do not answer, Emergency Medical Services will be dispatched.*
- 3. EMERGENCY PULL CORDS: When pulled the response system is notified. The alarm box on the porch will sound and the light will flash. You will receive a call to determine the nature of your emergency. If you do not answer, EMS will be dispatched. These can be reset by you (please refer to your Resident Handbook for instructions).
- 4. SMOKE ALARMS: Smoke alarms are hard-wired to the response system. When activated, someone will call you to determine the level of emergency and the response needed. The red light will flash outside of your home. If you do not answer, the Fire Department will be dispatched. The alarm will stop when the smoke is cleared. Back up batteries are changed annually by Lathrop. Please call or put in a work request if you hear chirps.
- 5. CARBON MONOXIDE DETECTORS: These are not hard-wired. If the alarm goes off, leave your unit and call 911. Batteries are changed annually by Lathrop.
